



Environmental Policy Statement

Overview

Black Knight's leadership team and broader employee base are committed to being the best possible stewards of our environment. An integral part of who we are, and our overall business strategy, is conducting ourselves and our business in a sustainable manner.

At Black Knight, we are committed to the following environmental principles:

- Conducting business in a manner that demonstrates responsibility and accountability for our impact on the environment;
- Adhering to, or acting in accordance with, all legal requirements related to the environment;
- Monitoring our environmental performance;
- Reducing emissions, releases and waste;
- Using natural resources and energy more efficiently;
- Reporting regularly on environmental issues and associated metrics; and
- Engaging with various stakeholder groups on relevant environmental, social and governance (ESG) topics.

This statement has been reviewed and approved by Black Knight's senior leadership and the Risk Committee of the Board of Directors, who maintain oversight of environmental, social and governance (ESG) risks.

Sustainability Initiatives

As part of our commitment to a promoting a sustainable future, we have several programs and initiatives in place directed at reducing environmental impacts:

- Energy efficiency
 - As a technology provider, we recognize that our greatest environmental impact is energy consumption and as such, we look for ways to reduce our energy use.
 - Our efforts to reduce our energy consumption and improve efficiency include, but are not limited to:
 - Replacing aging and end-of-life equipment with energy-efficient alternatives, such as Energy Star®-compliant technology
 - Using an automated demand response system to reduce our energy usage during peak demand times
 - Replacing roofs on our facilities and incorporating improved insulation
 - Using energy-efficient LED and compact fluorescent lamps (CFLs) on our corporate campuses

- Water conservation
 - We take a responsible approach to water conservation and consumption, including, but not limited to:
 - Using faucet flow restrictors in all our breakrooms and restrooms to reduce water consumption
 - Using soil-moisture managed irrigation on our corporate campus, and a no-concrete watering policy

- Waste management
 - We are committed to reducing our environmental footprint by shifting our business away from the use of paper toward increasingly digitized operations.
 - Where we do produce waste, we seek to dispose of it in an environmentally responsible manner.
 - Our waste management efforts include, but are not limited to:
 - Using an eStewards[®]-certified end-of-life equipment disposal vendor
 - Outsourcing the disposal of our sensitive documents to a third-party vendor that is committed to shredding and recycling in an environmentally responsible manner
 - Providing recycling bins in common areas to encourage our employees to recycle paper, cardboard, glass, plastic bottles and aluminum or steel cans
 - Adopting recyclable paper and cardboard products in our various office locations
 - Using Green Seal Certified[®] paper products and green-friendly cleaning products where possible

- GHG emissions reductions
 - We are reviewing an inventory of our GHG emissions so that we can understand where opportunities for improvement in terms of consumption exist.
 - As we have a better understanding of our performance, risks and opportunities, we will update key stakeholders.
 - In the near-term, we plan to report on our data collection process and associated metrics and move toward reporting aligned with the industry standards recommended by the Sustainability Accounting Standards Board (SASB).

Black Knight is committed to the continuous improvement and development of our sustainability initiatives.

Sustainability in Our Product Development Life Cycle

Over the last several years, Black Knight has been incorporating sustainable processes in our product development life cycle via the use of cleaner and more efficient technology that lessens our overall environmental impact. Examples of this include incorporating green software design into our software development life cycle process; adopting an application programming interface-first approach to product development to encourage component re-use; and database optimization techniques to support efficient data management.

Additionally, we support the sustainability initiatives of our clients by providing paperless solutions and other eco-friendly products and services. Examples include electronic invoicing and payment solutions, automated valuation models, remote closing capabilities and digital solutions.

Environmental Risk Management

At Black Knight, we manage environmental risks through our broader enterprise risk management (*ERM*) program. Within the ERM program, our enterprise business continuity (*EBC*) program oversees the plans for our core products, applications, processes and services that include predetermined actions to be taken, resources to be used, and procedures to be followed before, during, and after disasters or disruptions to business operations, including disasters or disruptions related to the environment such as weather events. The ERM and EBC programs are ultimately approved by the Risk Committee of our Board of Directors each year.

We have not identified any significant risks posed by our business operations that would have a substantive impact on the environment at this time. However, due to the digital nature of our product and service offerings, areas where our business operations could potentially pose environmental risks in the future include:

- Energy used to power our data centers and corporate campuses, inclusive of their associated equipment and devices
- GHG emissions associated with business travel and employee commuting

Monitoring, Reporting and Compliance

Black Knight strictly adheres to all local, state and federal environmental-related legislation and guidelines. In addition to maintaining strict compliance, Black Knight is committed to monitoring its overall environmental impact and will continue to develop its environmental strategy and associated risk management plan as additional frameworks, guidance and mandates are provided from governing bodies.

We are committed to regularly reporting on our environmental progress and to continuously improving our overall ESG programming.
